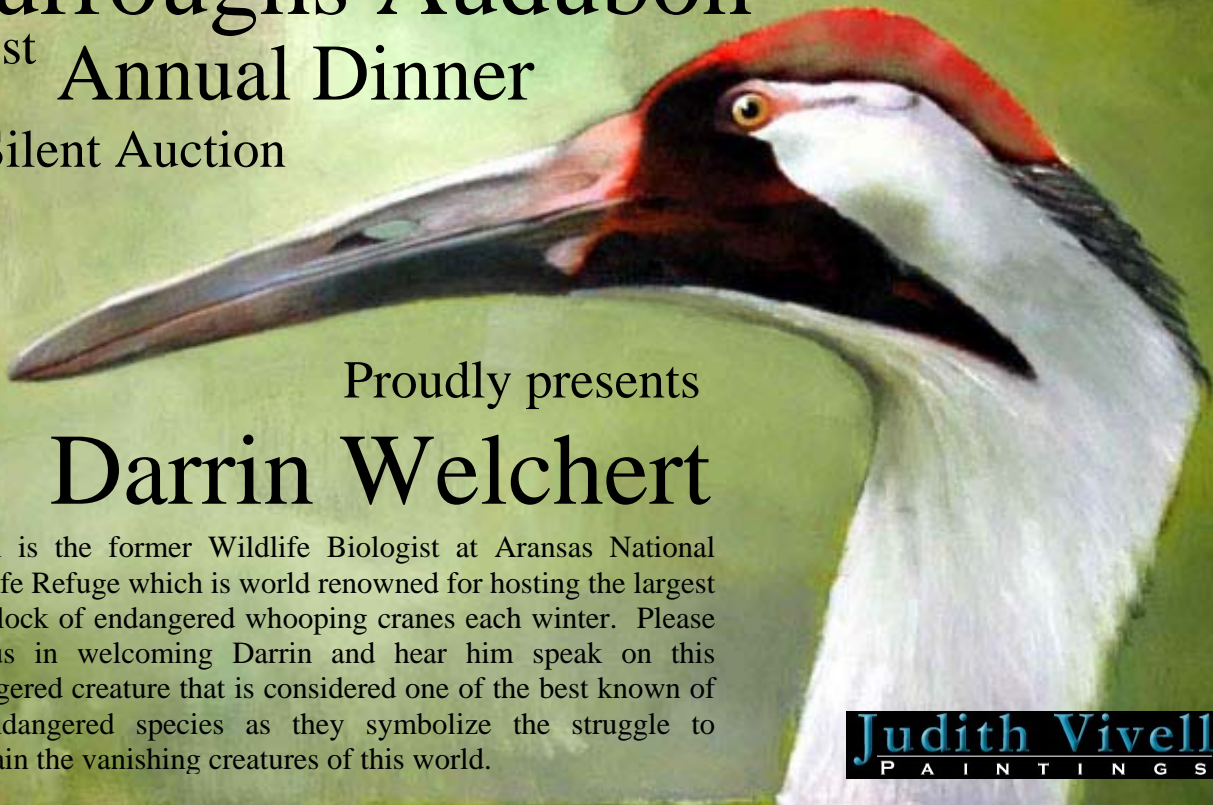


Burroughs Audubon 91st Annual Dinner & Silent Auction
